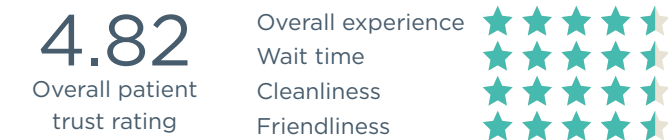

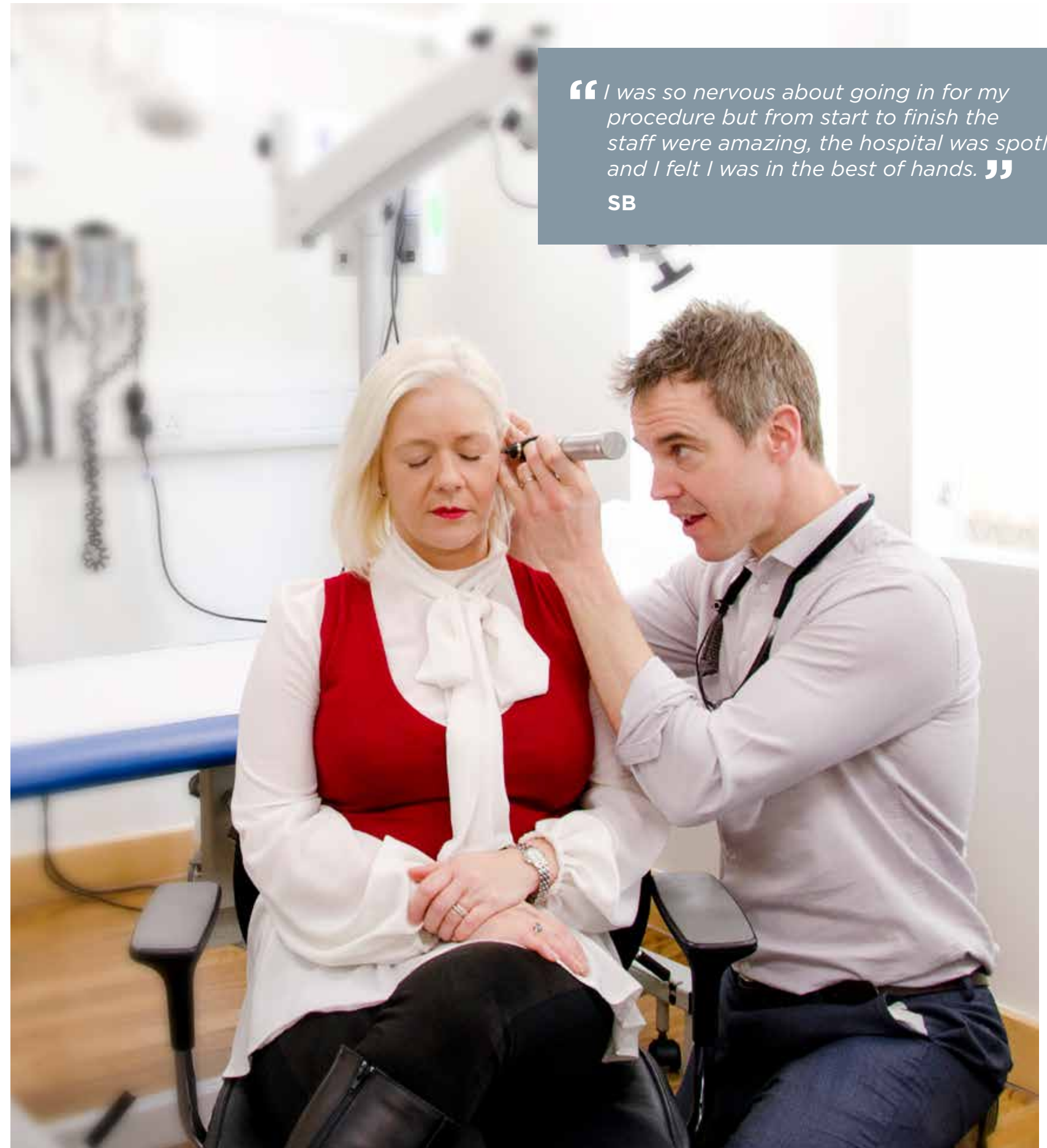

Our Imaging Department is fully equipped with the latest imaging equipment, including:

- Digital X-ray
- Interventional radiology (to perform minimally invasive, Image-guided procedures)
- 1.5T Wide Bore MRI scanner
- CT scanner
- Ultrasound.

These scans offer patients the highest quality imaging, which is vital for rapid diagnosis and improved outcomes.

A quality service

Our department is made up of registered radiographers and consultant radiologists. We follow the guidelines produced by the Royal College of Radiologists and College of Radiographers.

We are registered and regulated by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) and accredited by all major insurers, including BUPA, AXA Health and WPA.

Our department uses a fully integrated, digital picture archiving and communication system (PACS). This viewing system allows consultants to see investigations instantly in their consulting room or at any terminal in the hospital.

Referrals and appointments

Highgate Hospital offers a walk-in service for standard X-rays and can offer appointments on the same day for routine ultrasound scans. Patients are offered the first available appointment for CT, MRI and other complex scans or can choose an appointment time that suits them.

Physiotherapy

Our experienced chartered physiotherapists use the latest techniques, exercise tips and medical advice to treat patients in a dedicated physiotherapy suite.

We treat patients of all ages, who have had surgery or are experiencing physical challenges caused by illness, accident or ageing. These include:

- back, neck and shoulder pain
- upper and lower limb conditions
- sports injuries.

We recognise that everyone is different and tailor our services to the needs of each individual patient. For example, we offer:

- **Prehabilitation:** A complete assessment and treatment plan to maximise patients' physical condition and potential before an operation.
- **Post-operative rehabilitation:** A treatment programme to help patients recover after orthopaedic and other surgical procedures.

- **Sports injury assessment and treatment:** A detailed assessment and treatment plan for acute or chronic sports injuries.
- **Workstation assessment:** Practical advice and specialised stretching to treat posture and workstation-related problems, such as back and neck pain.
- **Pilates:** One-to-one Pilates sessions to improve patients' posture and core control while they recover from injury or chronic pain.

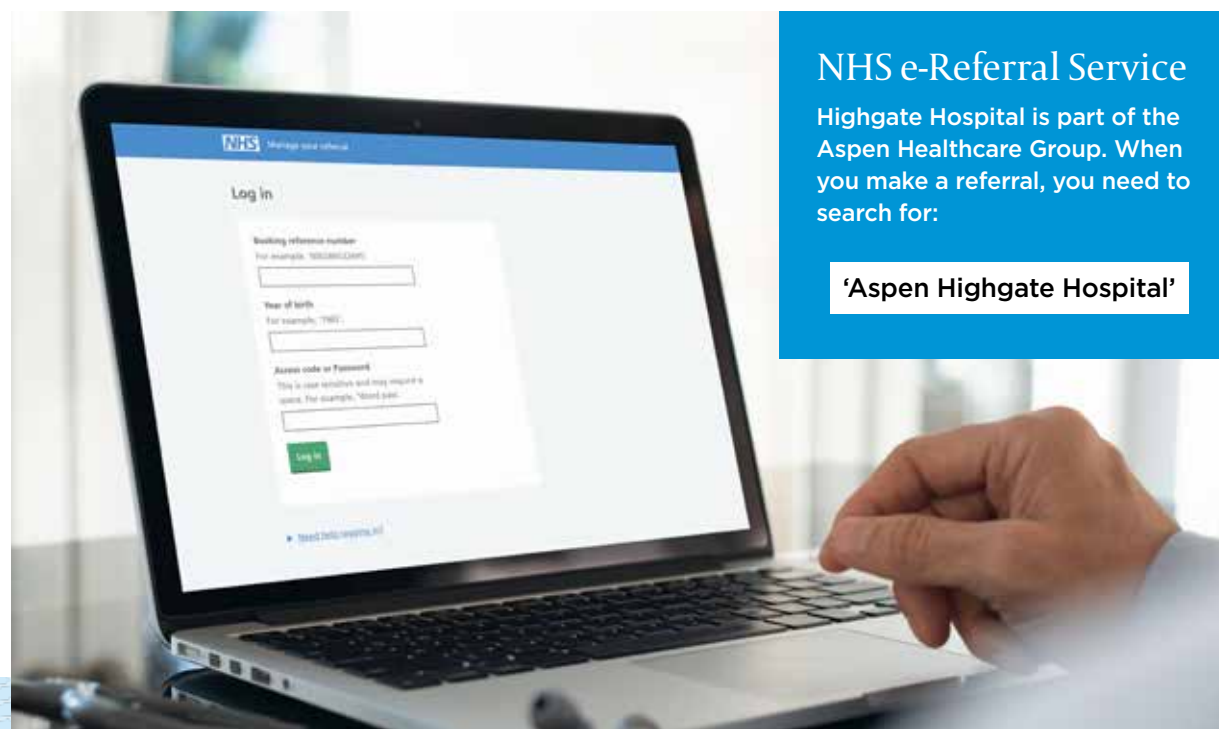

Supporting the **NHS** during the coronavirus (Covid-19) pandemic

The coronavirus pandemic is the biggest challenge that the NHS has faced in history. We have united with the NHS to make more hospital beds, healthcare staff and life-saving equipment urgently available in our local community. Kate Hoffmann, our Group Chief Nurse and Head of Clinical Services, explains, 'Nothing gives us greater pride than to stand with our NHS family at this time of national emergency.'

Partnership working

In March 2020, NHS England announced an historic agreement with independent sector hospitals. Under the partnership, Highgate Hospital made its full capacity available to the NHS. We provided a safe healthcare environment for non-coronavirus patients with urgent needs. This helped to reduce the unprecedented strain on the NHS. We have continued to support the NHS in 2021 and will do so for however long they need our help.

Our hospital has been praised in a report published by the Independent Healthcare Providers Network. The report, 'Working together during the COVID-19 pandemic', highlights our effective working partnership with Whittington Health NHS Trust in North London.

There are three main ways that we have worked closely with the NHS during the pandemic:

- **Caring for NHS patients at Highgate:** We quickly established efficient communication and IT links with the local Whittington Hospital. This enabled Whittington Hospital to book our 41 hospital beds on their Patient Administration System portal. As a result, we admitted NHS patients recovering from orthopaedic surgery. There were daily outpatient clinics at our hospital for NHS patients with weakened immune systems to receive biological therapy. We also set up regular clinics for NHS patients with Parkinson's disease and those who had suffered a fall.

- **Caring for patients on NHS wards:** We sent 30 clinical staff to be trained at Whittington Hospital and work on their busy wards. Our dedicated staff filled in for NHS shortages and cared for those in need, including frail elderly patients who tested positive for coronavirus. 50 of our staff also volunteered to work in the Nightingale Hospitals.

- **Transferring essential equipment to the NHS:** In April 2020, we loaned life-saving anaesthetic machines to Whittington Hospital. We also transferred seven Carescape monitors to them with the help of the British Army. These bedside monitors enable healthcare staff to observe critically ill patients continually and track the progress of those with coronavirus.

Douglas Watson, Hospital Director at Highgate Hospital, reflects, 'We have been working incredibly hard alongside the NHS to give patients the support that they need at this critical time. We know that London has been particularly hard hit from the coronavirus, and we remain determined to help the health service in whatever way we can.'

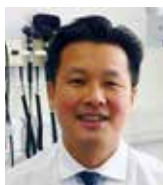

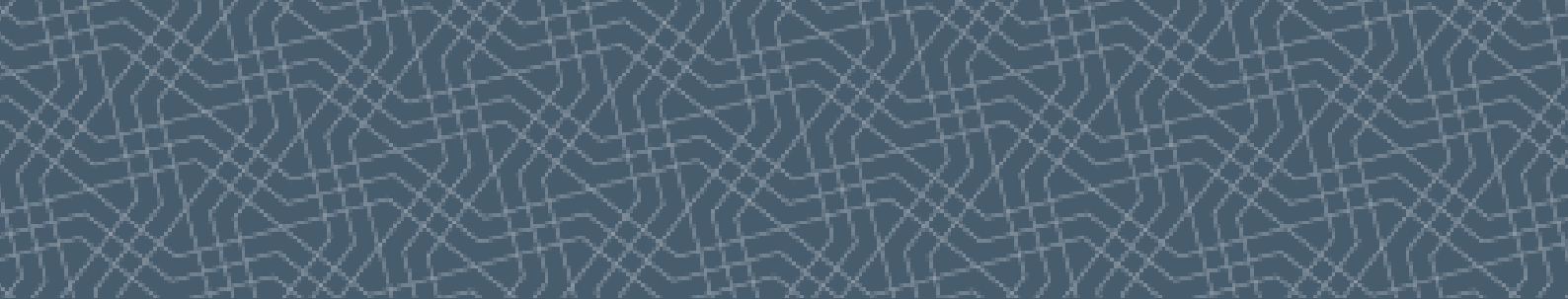
